Troubleshooting



Installing the Batteries




ATTENTION: Batteries should only be installed by an adult.

- The battery compartment is located on the bottom of the toy. Open the Cash Register drawer and turn unit over. Use a Phillips screwdriver to open the battery compartment door.
- 2. Install 3 "AA" (R6) batteries into the compartment, making sure that the + and - polarities match the diagram printed
- 3. Close the battery compartment door and tighten the battery door screw (do not over tighten).
